Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers in Iran

The Consumer Price Index (**CPI**) increased 1.2 percent in Dey 1392. The index level of 183.5 was 28.8 percent higher than in Dey 1391.

For the first ten months of 1392¹, the consumer price index rose 38.0 percent, compared to the similar period in 1391.

The inflation rate has advanced 38.4 percent over the last twelve months.

The food and beverages index turned up 2.2 percent in Dey, largely due to the increases in the indices for ground vegetables by 29.3 percent, arboreal fruits except citrus 4.9 percent, leafy green vegetables (except lettuce) 9.5 percent, root vegetables and eggs each 5.9 percent, fish (from the Persian Gulf and the Oman sea) 5.5 percent, vegetable products 2.3 percent, candy, chocolate, jam and honey 1.2 percent, mutton 0.6 percent, biscuit, cake and cookies 1.6 percent, cultured fish 4.1 percent, milk products 0.4 percent, pasteurized milk 0.6 percent, sauces and condiments 2.3 percent, non-alcoholic drinks 0.6 percent, walnut 0.8 percent, rice (imported) 0.2 percent, other cereal products 2.2 percent, oils and fats 0.1 percent, pasta and tangerine each 0.7 percent, canned fish 0.5 percent, meat products 0.8 percent, and almond 1.1 percent. Within the food and beverages group, decreases in the indices for citrus (except tangerine) by 10.3 percent, poultry 4.0 percent, pulses 1.5 percent, rice (high quality) 0.6 percent, lettuce 2.8 percent, rice (good quality) 0.5 percent, and tea 0.2 percent were also considerable in this month.

The index for tobacco went down 1.4 percent in Dey, reflecting 1.6 percent decrease in the index for imported cigarettes.

The clothing and footwear index rose 0.9 percent, mostly as a result of the increase in the index for ready to wear clothing by 0.8 percent. Advances of the indices for footwear by 1.2 percent, tailoring, cleaning and laundering wage 1.5 percent, and clothing materials 0.3 percent, accounted for the rise of this group index as well.

During this month, the housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels index increased 0.6 percent which was attributed to the advances of the indices for rental equivalence of owner occupied houses and rent of residential houses each by 0.6 percent, and maintenance and repair services of the dwelling 1.2 percent.

The furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance index rose 0.4 percent, mainly due to the rises in the indices for glassware, tableware and household utensils by 0.8 percent, and goods and services for routine household maintenance 0.7 percent. Within this group, increases in the indices for household appliances by 0.2 percent, and "carpets" and "household textiles" each 0.3 percent, were also considerable in this month.

The index for health went up 0.8 percent, mostly as a result of the increases in the indices for medical products, appliances and equipment by 1.3 percent, medical, paramedical and dental services 0.5 percent, and hospital services 0.6 percent.

The transport index rose 1.1 percent which was attributed to the increases of the indices for passenger transport by road by 0.7 percent, and maintenance and repair of personal transport equipment 2.7 percent.

The index for communication turned down 0.2 percent in Dey, reflecting 0.9 percent decrease in the index for telephone equipment.

The index for recreation and culture went down 0.1 percent, largely due to the decrease in the index for audio-visual, photographic and information processing equipments by 1.2 percent. Within this group, increases in the indices for package holidays (domestic) by 5.8 percent, flowers 8.4 percent, recreational and cultural services 0.9 percent, and stationery 0.5 percent, were also considerable in this month.

The education index was unchanged in Dey.

The index for restaurants and hotels increased 1.2 percent, mainly due to the advance in the index for food away from home by 1.3 percent.

The miscellaneous goods and services index went up 0.6 percent in this month. Increases in the indices for goldsmith wage by 2.2 percent, services of hairdressing salons and barbers 0.7 percent, personal effects 1.2 percent, and fees for legal services 0.8 percent were the major reasons for this rise.

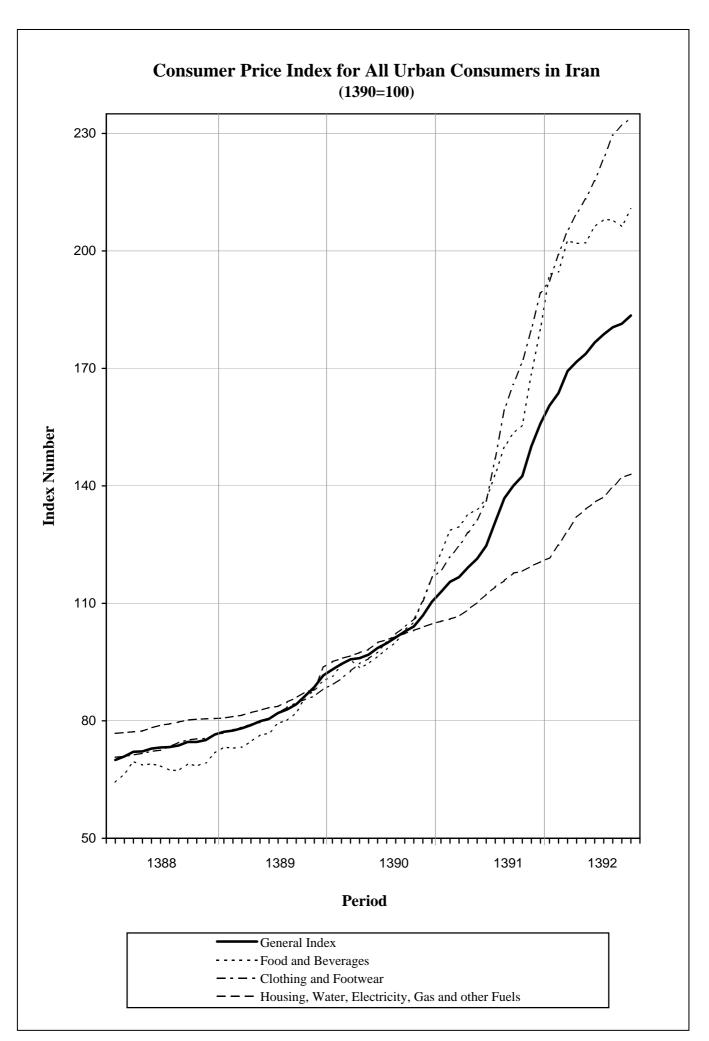
