ased on the data released by the Ministry of Jihad-e-Agriculture, in 1393, major agricultural products including farming, horticultural, livestock, and fishery products were estimated at about 104.2 million tons, showing 7.5 percent increase compared with the previous year. Based on preliminary data, the value-added of the agriculture sector increased by 3.8 percent in 1393 (at constant 1383 prices).

According to the Ministry of Energy, in 1392/93 farming year ¹, total precipitation amounted to 357.2 billion cubic meters (216.7 millimeters on average by area under cultivation), showing 9.2 percent decline compared with the previous farming year

and 11.0 percent decrease compared with the long-term average (45 years). Furthermore, the volume of surface water flows was estimated at 42.7 billion cubic meters, indicating 12.9 percent fall compared with the previous farming year and 51.6 percent reduction compared with the long-term average.

Farming² and Horticultural Products

Based on the data released by the Ministry of Jihad-e-Agriculture, in 1393, about 90.6 million tons of farming and horticultural

products were harvested, showing 7.8 percent increase compared with the previous year. Of total farming and horticultural products, 74.1 million tons (81.8 percent) were farming products, showing 8.8 percent increase compared with the year before. Moreover, horticultural products amounted to 16.5 million tons, indicating 3.5 percent growth.

Grain production (wheat, barley, rice husks, and corn) increased by 6.9 percent to 17.6 million tons. In 1393, production of wheat and barley rose by respectively 13.7 and 5.1 percent, while that of corn and rice fell by 10.4 and 4.2 percent compared with the year before.

In 1393, total production of agro-industrial crops¹ rose by 10.8 percent to 11.9 million tons. Moreover, production of sugar cane and sugar beet, with 55.5 and 39.9 percent

share among agro-industrial crops, amounted to 6.6 million tons and 4.7 million tons, respectively. Production of sugar beet experienced the highest rise among agro-industrial crops by 36.4 percent.



Livestock and Fishery Products

According to the Ministry of Jihad-e-Agriculture, total livestock products (red meat, milk, poultry, eggs, and honey) amounted to 12.6 million tons in 1393, showing a rise of 5.5 percent compared with the previous year.

Fishery products totaled 947 thousand tons, showing 7.1 percent growth compared with the previous year. It is to be noted that 56.6 percent of fishery products were related to the Persian Gulf, 4.2 percent to the Caspian Sea, and 39.3 percent to the aquaculture centers. The volume and value of fishery exports were 72 thousand tons and \$300 million, down by respectively 0.02 and 1.4 percent compared with the year before.

Guaranteed Purchase of Major Agricultural Products

The guaranteed purchase of agricultural products, aimed at producing basic agricultural goods, establishing a balanced production system, and maintaining farmers' income level, has been a government policy over the recent years. In 1392/93 farming year, the guaranteed purchase price of all farming products increased. The highest increase in the guaranteed purchase price of agricultural products was related to "kidney bean" and "lentil" by respectively 97.8 and 96.1 percent, to reach Rls. 17,800 and Rls. 20,000 per kilogram.

Subsidies

In 1393, subsidy paid on goods and services (subject of Budgetary Measure No. 520000) reached Rls. 151.8 trillion. Of this amount, a sum of Rls. 55.2 trillion was paid on agricultural goods, services, and activities, constituting 36.4 percent of total subsidy payment out of the mentioned Budgetary Measure.

Government Investment

Based on the data released by the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Finance, in 1393, government credits for the acquisition of non-financial-national assets for the development of "agriculture and natural resources" and "water resources" amounted to Rls. 21.1 trillion, showing a decrease by 5.3 percent compared with the previous year. Therefore, 68.3 percent of total approved credits (Rls. 30.9 trillion) were realized. Credits for the acquisition of non-financial national assets projects paid to "agriculture and natural resources" sector fell by 11.9 percent to Rls. 5.8 trillion. National expenditures for the acquisition of non-financial assets projects for the development of "water resources" amounted to Rls. 15.3 trillion, down by 2.6 percent compared with the year before.



Banking Facilities

Outstanding facilities extended by banks and non-bank credit institutions to public and non-public agriculture sectors grew by 17.5 percent to Rls. 537.0 trillion by end-1393. The share of non-public agriculture sector in outstanding facilities was 99.1 percent.


By end-1393, outstanding facilities extended by Bank Keshavarzi Iran (Agriculture Bank of Iran) to non-public agriculture sector rose by 18.4 percent to Rls. 304.1 trillion. Share of Bank Keshavarzi Iran in total outstanding facilities extended to public and non-public agriculture sectors was 56.8 percent, showing 0.3 percentage point growth compared with 1392.

In 1393, Bank Keshavarzi Iran paid Rls. 253.7 trillion through non-statutory and statutory facilities, administered funds, and contracts, up by 20.7 percent compared with the year before. Of total credits paid by this bank, 88.4 percent (Rls. 224.3 trillion) were from non-statutory resources, and 11.6 percent were in the form of statutory facilities, administered funds, and contracts.

Composition of facilities extended by Bank Keshavarzi Iran according to Islamic contracts indicates the high share of civil partnership contracts. In 1393, a sum of Rls. 136.1 trillion was paid in the form of civil partnership contracts, constituting 53.6

percent of facilities and showing 32.8 percent rise compared with last year. Composition of facilities extended by this bank by use shows that "farming and horticulture" activity, enjoying the highest share in total facilities by 32.8 percent, increased by 18.8 percent to Rls. 83.1 trillion.

Agricultural Insurance Fund

In 1392/93 farming year, about Rls. 8.9 trillion was paid by Agricultural Insurance Fund as compensation, showing an increase of 10.6 percent compared with the previous farming year.

Since this Fund is a loss-making institution, a large proportion of its commitments on compensations are financed through government subsidies. Share of government subsidies in total paid compensation was about 68.5 percent in 1392/93 farming year, while only 31.5 percent was financed out of farmers' premium payments. Due to the government failure in timely fulfillment of its commitments, Bank Keshavarzi Iran has

continually been the body in charge of financing the deficit of the Agricultural Insurance Fund over the past years.

According to the report released by the Agricultural Insurance Fund, in 1392/93 farming year, this Fund insured 4.4 million hectares of lands under cultivation of 60 farming and horticultural products against losses from natural disasters. The area of insured land shows 6.9 percent decrease compared with the previous year. In 1393, a sum of Rls. 6.7 trillion was paid by the Fund as compensation, indicating 13.4 percent increase compared with 1392.

Performance of Rural, Women, and Agricultural Cooperatives and Unions

According to the Central Organization for Rural Cooperatives, the number of active rural, women, and agricultural cooperatives reached 5,113 by end-1393. These cooperatives covered 5.5 million rural dwellers. This indicated 1.7 percent increase in terms of the number of cooperatives and 0.1 percent rise in terms of members.

By end-1393, the number of cooperative unions increased by 2.8 percent to 409 and member companies in small cities fell by 3.2 percent to reach 3,764.

Rural cooperatives purchased about 2.7 million tons of various agricultural products at agreed prices in 1393, down by 22.8 percent compared with the year before. In 1393,

cooperatives purchased 880 thousand tons of various agricultural products at guaranteed prices.

Exports of Agricultural Products

Based on the data released by the Ministry of Jihad-e-Agriculture, 5.5 million tons of various agricultural products, worth \$6.7 billion, were exported in 1393, indicating 33.1 and 24.7 percent increase in terms of volume (weight) and value, compared with the previous year. Exports of agricultural products accounted for 6.8 percent of volume and 18.4 percent of value of total exports through Customs. In 1393, "farming products" accounted for 55.1 percent of total agricultural exports in terms of volume, while "horticultural products", despite a lower share of 19.6 percent in the volume of agricultural exports, accounted for 41.4 percent of total value of agricultural exports.

Imports of Agricultural Products

According to the Ministry of Jihade-Agriculture, approximately 22.7 million tons of various agricultural products valued at \$12.3 billion were imported, indicating 23.1 percent increase in terms of volume and 9.1 percent fall in terms of value. Imports of agricultural products accounted for 22.9 percent of value and 52.7 percent of volume of total imported products. The average value of each ton of imported agricultural products was \$542, down by 26.2 percent compared with the previous year.

Imports of wheat amounted to 7.2 million tons in 1393, representing 82.7 percent rise compared with 4.0 million tons in 1392.

A review of the developments of foreign trade shows that trade deficit of the agriculture sector decreased by 31.7 percent to \$5.6 billion in 1393.

The average per ton value of exported agricultural products decreased by 6.3 percent to \$1,219 in 1393. Considering the composition of agricultural imports and exports, terms of trade of the agriculture sector increased by 26.9 percent from 1.8 in 1392 to 2.2 in 1393.
