## **Consumer Price Index In Urban Areas in Iran**

Mordad 1383

(1376=100)

The Consumer Price Index (**CPI**) went up 0.7 percent in Mordad 1383. Showing the index point of 269.5, the **CPI** was 14.9 percent higher than the similar month in 1382.

During the first five months of the current Iranian year, the Consumer Price Index rose 14.4 percent, compared to the similar period in 1382.

The inflation rate increased by 14.6 percent during the twelve months ending Mordad 1383.

During Mordad 1383, the food, beverages and tobacco group index rose 0.4 percent, mainly due to increase of “fresh fruits” index by 4.7 percent and “eggs” index by 8.6 percent and “rice” index by 1.4 percent. In the mentioned month the “poultry” and “fresh vegetables” group index decreased by 9.9 percent and 4.2 percent, respectively.

The clothing and footwear group index went up 0.5 percent. In the mentioned month, the “ready to wear clothing” group index increased by 0.3 percent. The indices of “apparel goods and services” and “footwear” increased by 0.9 percent and 0.4 percent, respectively.

During Mordad 1383, the housing, water, fuel and power group index went up 1.3 percent. The “rental equivalence of owner occupied houses” index and the “rent of residential houses” index, each increased by 1.4 percent. The indices of “maintenance and repair services” rose 1.4 percent.

The household furnishings and operations group index rose 0.8 percent. This advance was mainly due to increase of “household furnishings” group index by 0.8 percent.

The transportation and communication group index went up 0.1 percent, this advance was attributed to 0.3 percent increase in the “public transportation” group index.

During Mordad 1383, the medical care group index increased by 0.5 percent, this advance was attributed to 0.6 percent increase in the “medical care services” group index. In the given month the “medicines” group index remained unchanged.

The recreation, reading and education group index rose 0.1 percent. In this month, the “recreation” group index and the “reading and education” group index each increased by 0.1 percent.

The miscellaneous goods and services group index went up 0.5 percent.

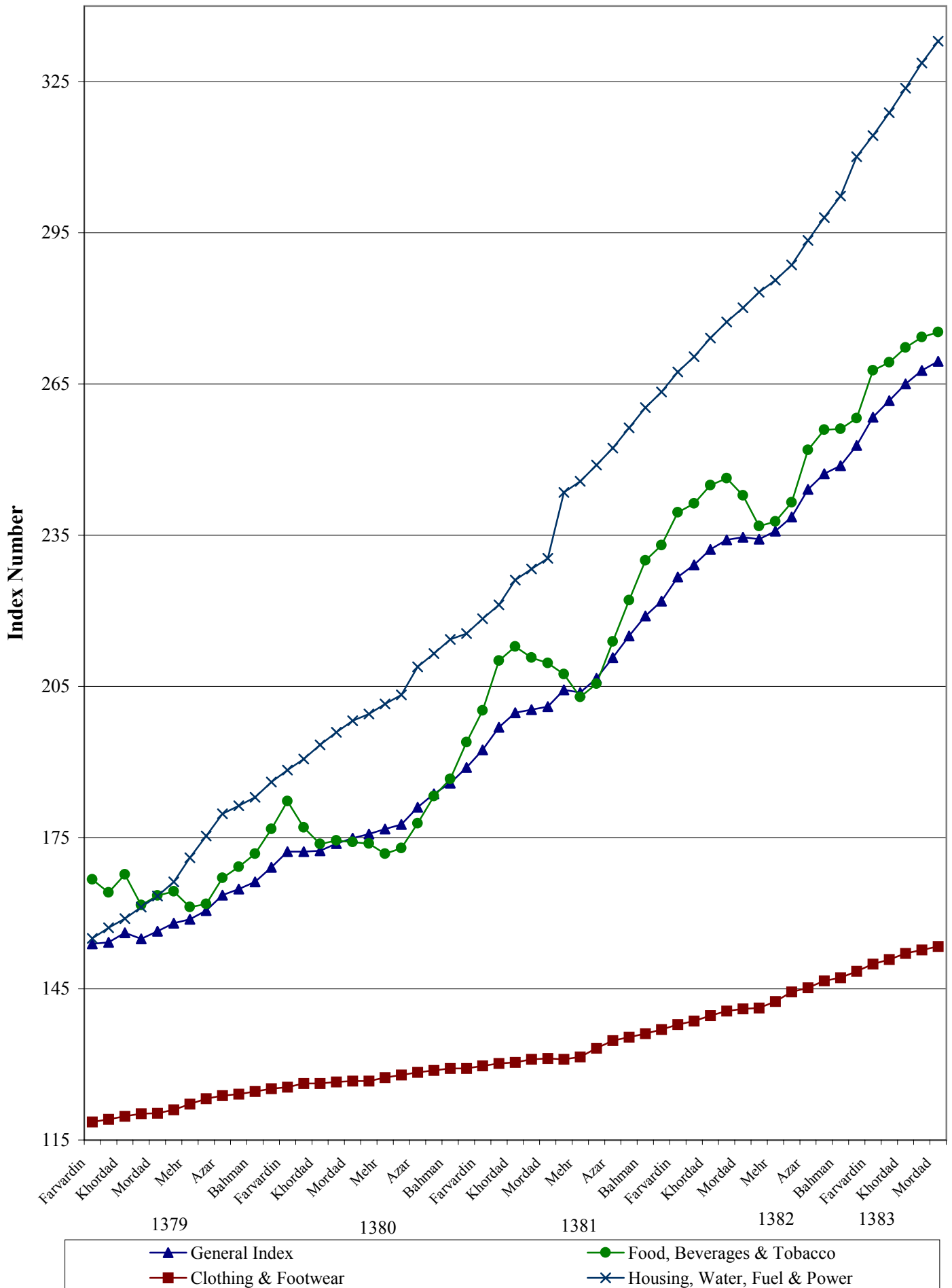
