## **Consumer Price Index in Urban Areas in Iran**

Mordad 1384

(1376=100)

The Consumer Price Index (**CPI**) went down 0.1 percent in Mordad 1384. Showing the index point of 298.6, the **CPI** was 10.8 percent higher than the similar month in 1383.

During the first five months of the current Iranian year, the Consumer Price Index rose 14.0 percent, compared to the similar period in 1383.

The inflation rate increased 15.0 percent during twelve months ending Mordad 1384.

During Mordad 1384, the food, beverages and tobacco group index went down 1.9 percent, mainly due to decrease of “fresh fruits” index by 14.9 percent and “fresh vegetables” index by 5.7 percent. The indices of “poultry”, “eggs” and “sugar and sugar lump” increased 5.5 percent, 6.3 percent and 3.4 percent, respectively.

The clothing and footwear group index increased 0.4 percent, mainly due to increase of “footwear” index by 0.9 percent. The indices of “ready to wear clothing” and “apparel goods and services” increased 0.3 percent and 0.1 percent, respectively.

During Mordad 1384, the housing, water, fuel and power group index went up 1.0 percent. The “rental equivalence of owner occupied houses” group index and the “rent of residential houses” group index, each increased 1.1 percent. The index of “maintenance and repair services” increased 1.0 percent.

The household furnishings and operations group index rose 0.5 percent. This advance was mainly due to increase of “household furnishings” group index by 0.4 percent. The “household goods and services” group index increased 0.8 percent.

The transportation and communication group index rose 0.2 percent. In the given month, the index of “public transportation” increased by 0.6 percent. The index of “private transportation” remained unchanged.

During Mordad 1384, the medical care group index went up 1.2 percent, mainly due to increase of “medical services” group index by 1.4 percent. In the given month the “medicines” group index increased 0.2 percent.

The recreation, reading and education group index went up 0.2 percent.

The miscellaneous goods and services group index went up 0.3 percent.

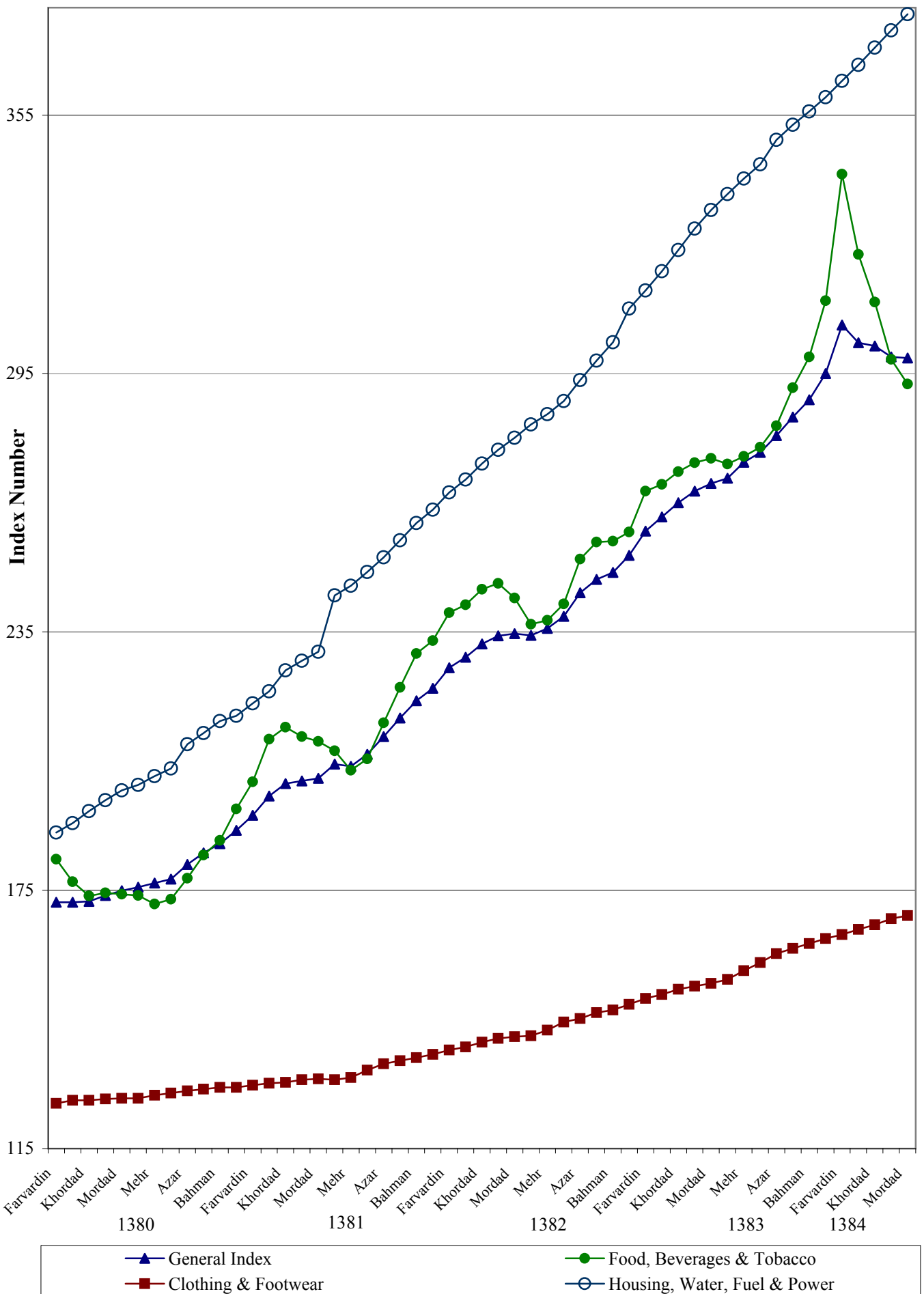
