Consumer Price Index in Urban Areas in Iran

Mehr 1385

(1376=100)

The Consumer Price Index (**CPI**) went up 1.5 percent in Mehr 1385. Showing the index point of 349.3, the **CPI** was 15.1 percent higher than the similar month in 1384.

During the first seven months of the current Iranian year, the Consumer Price Index rose 11.6 percent compared to the similar period in 1384.

The inflation rate increased 11.2 percent during twelve months ending Mehr 1385.

During Mehr 1385, the food, beverages and tobacco group index went up 1.2 percent, mainly due to the increase of “meat” index by 2.7 percent. In this group the indices of “fresh vegetables”, “cereal products”, “eggs” and “pulses” rose 4.6 percent, 4.4 percent, 4.7 percent and 4.6 percent, respectively. In the given month, the index of “fresh fruits” decreased 2.2 percent.

The clothing and footwear group index went up 1.0 percent, mainly due to the increase of “ready to wear clothing” index by 1.2 percent. The indices of “footwear” and “apparel goods and services” rose 1.0 percent and 0.4 percent, respectively.

During Mehr 1385, the housing, water, fuel and power group index went up 1.8 percent. The indices of the “rental equivalence of owner occupied houses” and the “rent of residential houses” each increased 1.8 percent. The index of “maintenance and repair services” increased 1.7 percent.

The household furnishings and operations group index rose 1.0 percent. This advance was mainly due to the increase of “household furnishings” group index by 0.9 percent. The “household goods and services” group index increased 1.3 percent.

The transportation and communication group index went up 0.5 percent. In the given month, the indices of “private transportation” and “public transportation” increased 0.7 percent and 0.4 percent, respectively.

During Mehr 1385, the medical care group index went up 1.1 percent, mainly due to the increase of “medical services” group index by 1.2 percent. In the given month the “medicines” group index increased 0.4 percent.

The recreation, reading and education group index went up 7.4 percent, mainly due to the increase of “reading and education” group index by 9.3 percent. This advance was largely caused by the increase of “university tuition fees” index by 11.7 percent.

The miscellaneous goods and services group index went up 1.5 percent. In the given month, the prices for “funeral expenses” increased by 3.5 percent.

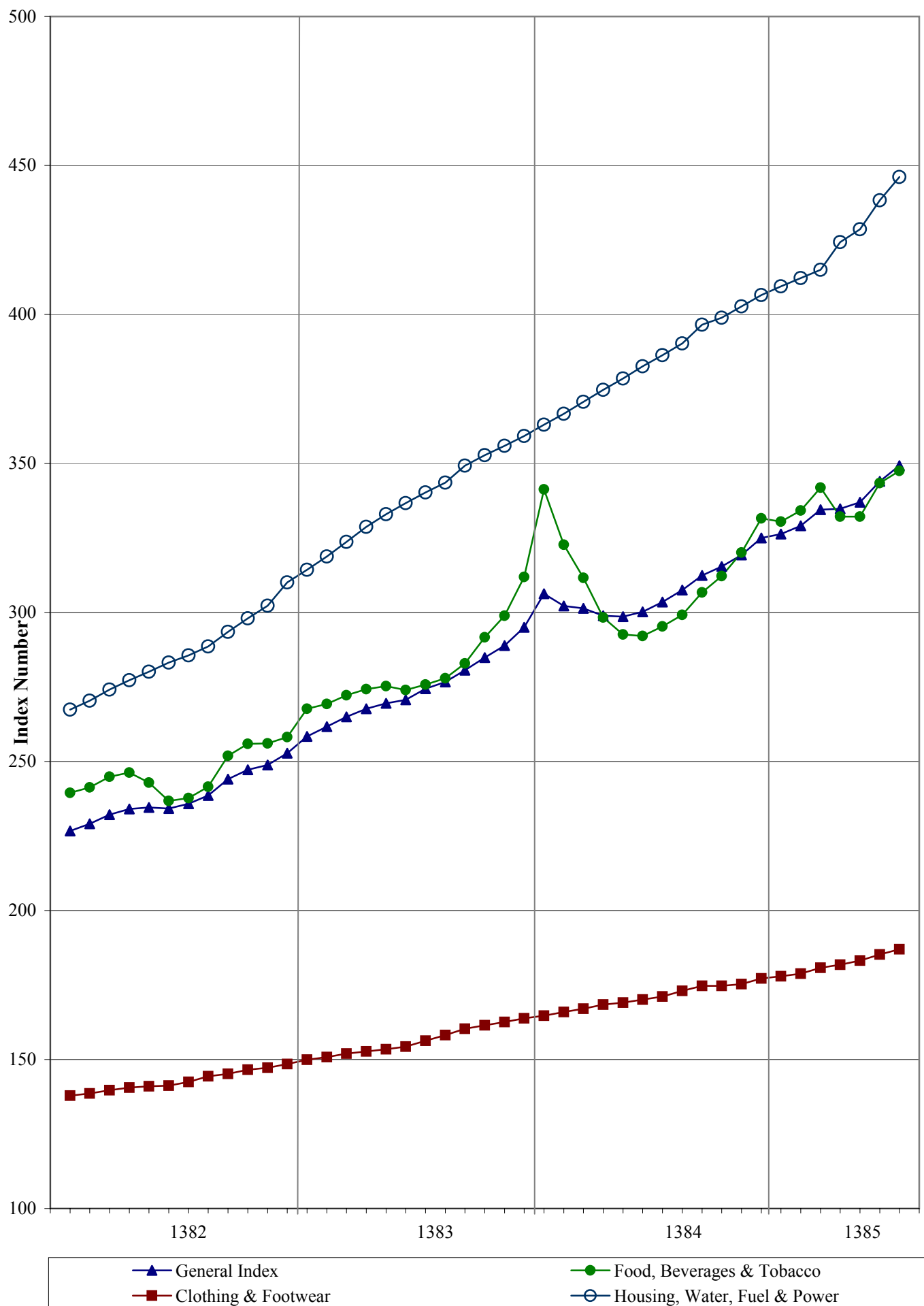
