Mordad 1386

(1376 = 100)

The Wholesale Price Index **(WPI)** had no change in Mordad 1386. Showing the index point of 331.9, the **WPI** was 15.2 percent higher than the similar month in 1385.

During the first five months of the current Iranian year, the Wholesale Price Index rose 15.9 percent compared to the similar period in 1385.

The Wholesale Price Index increased 15.6 percent during the last twelve months leading to Mordad 1386 compared with the similar preceding period.

In Mordad, the food group index fell 0.9 percent, which was mainly attributed to the decrease in the prices of fresh fruits and vegetables, chicken and rice (home product). In this group, the prices of mutton, the Persian Gulf fish, dairy products, eggs, pulses, barley (home product) and exported pistachio increased.

The beverages and tobacco group index and the mineral fuels and related materials group index had no change.

The crude materials, inedible, except fuels group index rose 0.7 percent.

The chemical and petrochemical products group index went down 0.2 percent.

The manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials group index increased 0.9 percent, which was mainly due to the increase in the prices of hand-made carpets and rugs, bricks, iron slabs, iron coils, and black iron pipes.

The advance in the prices of imported lamps, wall and contact plugs and copper cables mainly caused 1.1 percent rise in the group index of machinery and transport equipment.

The miscellaneous manufactured articles group index went up 2.2 percent.

In the special groups, the farm, livestock and fishing products group index fell 2.1 percent and the building materials group index rose 0.7 percent.


