Consumer Price Index in Urban Areas in Iran

Mordad 1387

(1383=100)

The Consumer Price Index (**CPI**) went up 1.8 percent in Mordad 1387. Showing the index point of 178.7, the **CPI** was 27.6 percent higher than the similar month in 1386.

During the first five months of the current Iranian year, the Consumer Price Index rose 25.9 percent, compared to the similar period in 1386.

The inflation rate increased 22.3 percent during twelve months ending Mordad 1387.

During Mordad 1387, the food and beverages group index increased 1.7 percent, mainly due to the increase of the prices for “poultry”, “orange”, “bread”, “apple”, “peach”, “pasteurized cheese”, “lettuce”, “cucumber”, “tomato paste”, “beef”, “fish”, “banana”, “pasteurized butter”, “yogurt”, “pasta” and “watermelon” by 11.8 percent, 7.2 percent, 5.7 percent, 5.1 percent, 30.6 percent, 7.7 percent, 15.4 percent, 5.7 percent, 4.1 percent, 1.6 percent, 3.2 percent, 8.8 percent, 6.2 percent, 1.8 percent, 4.1 percent and 3.6 percent, respectively. In this group, the indices of “rice”, “lime”, “tomato”, “potato”, “grapes”, “eggs”, “eggplant”, “honeydew melon and cantaloup” and “melon” decreased 3.5 percent, 18.8 percent, 10.0 percent, 10.5 percent, 5.2 percent, 1.6 percent, 9.3 percent, 4.7 percent and 2.3 percent, respectively.

During Mordad 1387, the tobacco group index decreased 0.5 percent.

The clothing and footwear group index rose 1.3 percent, largely as a result of the increase in “ready to wear clothing” index by 1.0 percent. In this group, the index of “footwear” went up 1.8 percent.

The housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels group index rose 2.1 percent, mainly due to the increase of the indices for the “rental equivalence of owner occupied houses” and the “rent of residential houses” each by 2.0 percent. In this month the index of “maintenance and repair services” went up 2.2 percent.

The furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance group index rose 1.0 percent. This advance was mainly due to the rise of the indices for the “goods and services for routine household maintenance” and “household appliances” by 1.6 percent and 0.9 percent, respectively.

During Mordad 1387, the medical care group index went up 1.6 percent, largely as a result of the increase in the indices for “medical, paramedical and dental services” and “hospital services” by 1.8 percent and 2.0 percent, respectively.

The transportation group index rose 3.8 percent. In this group the indices for “personal transport vehicles” and “transport services” each increased by 0.5 percent.

In this month the communication group index decreased 0.1 percent.

The recreation and culture group index increased 0.9 percent.

The education group index went up 0.6 percent.

The restaurants and hotels group index rose 1.4 percent, principally due to the increase of “food away from home ” index by 1.4 percent.

The miscellaneous goods and services group index went up 1.6 percent.

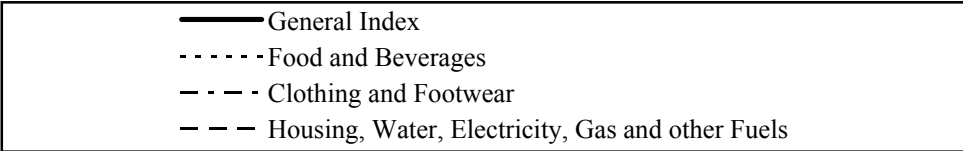
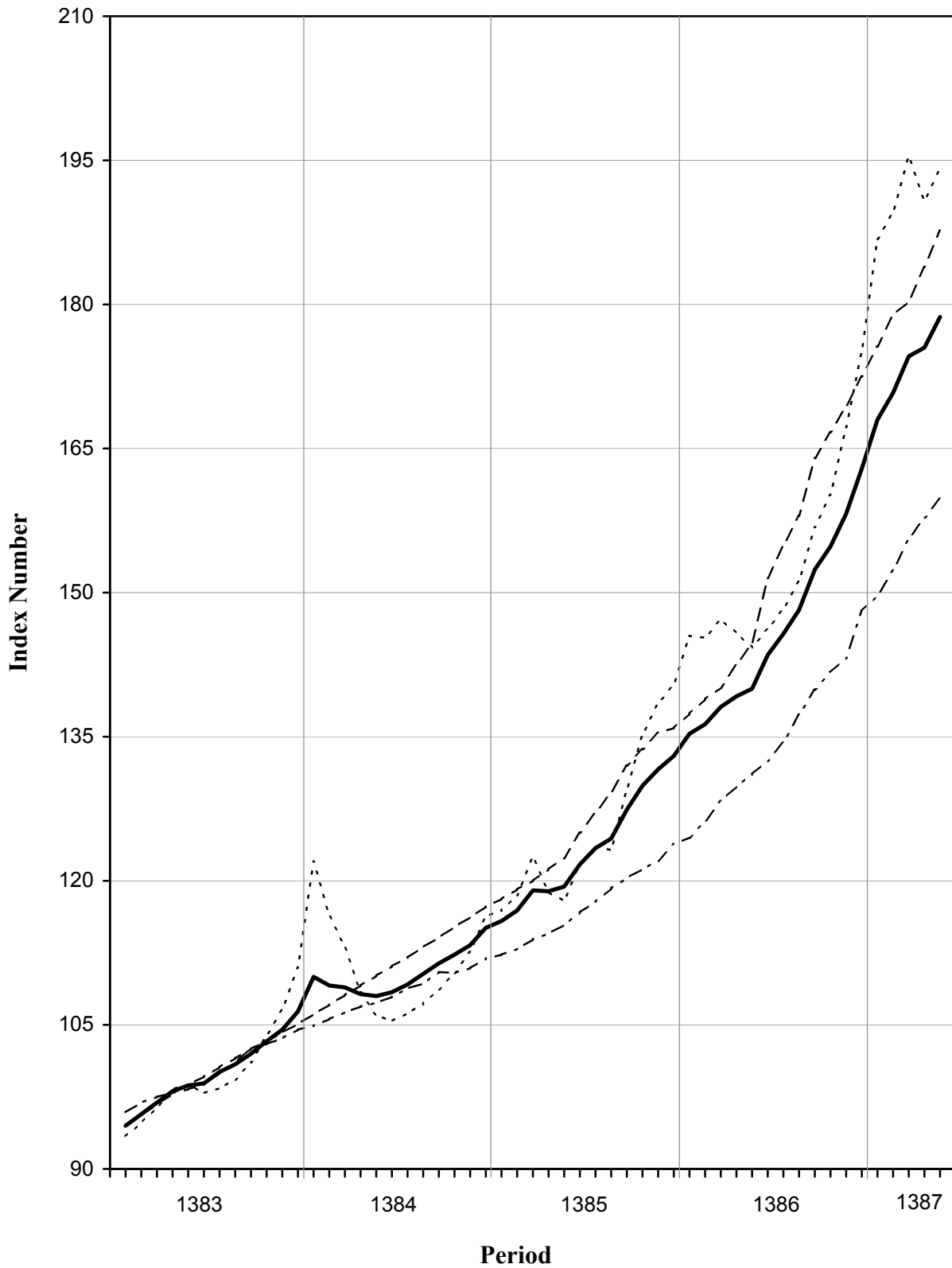
