Producer Price Index in Iran

Mordad 1389

(1383 = 100)

The Producer Price Index (PPI) went up 2.1 percent in Mordad 1389. The index level of 199.0 was 10.1 percent higher than in Mordad 1388.

For the first five months of 1389, the Producer Price Index rose 10.2 percent, compared to the similar period in 1388.

The Producer Price Index has advanced 7.8 percent over the last twelve months.

In Mordad, the agriculture, hunting and forestry group index went up 5.2 percent, which was mainly attributed to the rise in the indices for wheat, barley, lucerne, patch products, garden vegetables, fruits with seeds, fruits with tiny pits, farming of cattle, sheep and goat, poultry and egg. In this group, the prices for cane and fruits with pits moved down.

The fishing group index increased 0.7 percent.

As a result of rising in the indices for dried nuts and fruits, oil cake, raw fabric, oil cuts, methanol, exported methanol, exported ammonia, animal vaccines, plastic sheet, cement pipe, manufacture of basic iron and steel, copper wire and copper cable, the manufacturing group index went up 1.7 percent. In this group, the prices for caviar, manufacture of cubed sugar and sugar, exported

pentane, urea, low density polyethylene, generator and telecommunications cable decreased.

The hotels and restaurants group index moved up 1.1 percent.

The transport, storage and communications group index and the education group index went up 0.1 percent, each.

The 1.3 percent rise in the group index for health and social work was mostly due to the increase in the index for hospital activities and medical and dental practice activities.

The other community, social and personal service activities group index increased 0.8 percent.


