

Producer Price Index in Iran

Shahrivar 1397

(1395 = 100)

The Producer Price Index (PPI) went up 9.4 percent in Shahrivar 1397. The index level of 157.8 was 44.4 percent higher than in Shahrivar 1396.

For the first 6 months of 1397, the PPI edged up 25.1 percent, compared to the similar period in 1396.


This index moved up 18.2 percent for the 12 months ended in Shahrivar 1397.

Agriculture, forestry and fishing: In Shahrivar, a 8.1-percent increase in the prices of this group can be traced to the rises in the indices for oily sunflowers, potatoes, tomatoes, hay, grapes, dates, tangerines, fresh nuts, animal production and Persian gulf fishes. In contrast, prices for cucumbers, garlic, lemons and raising of poultry went down.

Manufacturing: The Manufacturing group index moved up 13.9 percent, which was mostly due to the rises in the indices for canned fish, pulse conserves, jams, dried nuts and fruits, vinegar, manufacture of vegetable oils, manufacture of prepared meals, tomato paste, manufacture of soft drinks, preparation and spinning of textile fibres, weaving of textiles, manufacture of made-up textile articles, manufacture of carpets and rugs, fishing nets, manufacture of narrow woven fabrics, manufacture of footwear, manufacture of paper and paper products, pentane, manufacture of refined petroleum products, tar, sulfur, dioctyl phthalate, exported methanol, ammonia and its products, exported fertilizers and nitrogen compounds, manufacture of plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms, manufacture of plastic paints, antifreeze, manufacture of man-made fibres, "manufacture of pharmaceuticals, medicinal chemical and botanical products", manufacture of plastics products, manufacture of glass and glass products, refractory bricks, manufacture of tiles, porcelain, cement pole and small beam, manufacture of basic iron and steel, production of copper, production of aluminium, production of lead and zinc, manufacture of structural metal products, manufacture of metal containers for compressed gas and central heating boilers, manufacture of steam generators, metal cans, electrodes, manufacture of optical disk drives, gas meter, manufacture of electrical equipment, industrial valves, "manufacture of bearings, gears, gearing and driving elements", lift truck, scales and weighbridges, manufacture of metal-rolling mills and rolls for such mills, manufacture of sewing machines, manufacture of motor vehicles, manufacture of trailers and semi-trailers, manufacture of parts and accessories for motor vehicles engines, bicycles, manufacture of furniture, manufacture of medical and dental instruments and supplies, and manufacture of pens and pencils. On the contrary, prices for sodium hydroxide and benzene declined.

Services: Increases in the indices of passenger air transport, restaurants and event catering mainly led to 3.0 percent rise in the services group index.
